

Jury Duty Notices

Our office has been made aware of an increase in scam calls and letters related to jury duty. Be advised that the Courts **does not request or accept payment** for any purpose by phone, email, or text message. Please note that the following are the **only official notices** you should receive from the Courts and should be received in this order:

- **Postcard Notice** – Informs you that you have been placed in the jury pool for the upcoming year.
- **Initial Notice Letter** – Notifies you that you have been selected for a specific term of service. This may be for **Grand Jury** or **Petit Jury** duty.
- **Appearance Notice** – Provides the required **date and time** to report for jury service.

If you receive any communication claiming to be related to jury duty that does not match the descriptions above, please treat it as suspicious and contact the Court directly to verify its legitimacy.
